The Trolley Waiting Station will be coming home. In November 2003, the 10' by 12' wooden trolley station that sat at the top of "Pen Hill," was saved by a dedicated group of volunteers. It was relocated to a maintenance facility on Butternut Drive in DeWitt. This 100+ year-old building has been moved several times during its lifetime. One last move will find a refurbished building returning to Jamesville. It will be located in Grist Mill Park (corner of Route 173 & Route 91).

Through the cooperation of the Town of DeWitt, Town of DeWitt Maintenance Department, and Town Supervisor Ed Michalenko, your Jamesville Community Museum will acquire and restore this unique building. Our efforts at restoration will be directed by Greg Titus and Jack Conlon. Additionally, we are anticipating the participation of a local Boy Scout who will be working on his Eagle Award.
